Alboraya

Alboraya is an attractive town which is located just 3 kilometers north of the city of Valencia itself and which preserves the typical essence of the towns of l'Horta Nord region.

Its landscape still maintains the old barracks, hermitages and farmhouses. With an exceptional climate to enjoy its beaches, this region invites us to discover the beaches of Port Saplaya and La Patacona, divided by the ravine Barranco del Carraixet and the Natural Park of Els Peixets. In addition, its extensive orchards reflecting an agricultural legacy of Arabic heritage with tigermut and vegetable fields make Alboraya a unique landscape. Likewise, its great horchata, a traditional drink made from nuts or rice, also stands out, thereby placing Alboraya as the cradle of this beverage.

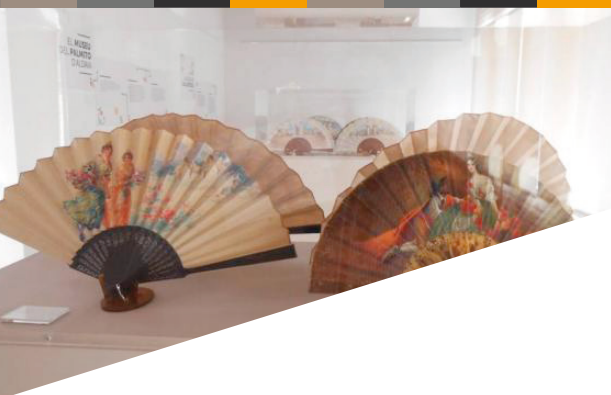

Aldaia

Aldaia offers interesting cultural experiences such as the museum known as Museo del Palmito (MUPA), which has a permanent collection. Here we can witness how Aldaia's artisans have been developing the noble trade of manufacturing fans since the 19th century, by working with wood, mother-of-pearl and bone to make fans of exquisite beauty.

Also worth-visiting are the Church of La Asunción from the 15th century, the cistern used for water supply from the 14th century, the manor Casa de la Llotgeta from the 16th century and the hermitages, or hermitas, of La Virgen de la Saleta and San Miguel, both declared Asset of Local Relevance.

Alzira

The town has an interesting historical-cultural legacy whose main vestiges can be seen in the city hall of the 16th century known as Casa de la Vila, the medieval walls and the Monastery of La Murta. Its municipal term encompasses fertile lands crossed by the Júcar River and mountainous areas that host natural places of singular beauty such as La Casella, La Murta and El Cavall de Bernat. Just 40 km away from Valencia, it can be accessed by the A-7 highway, Valencia-Almansa railway line, Valencia C2 and intercity buses from Carcaixent, Algemés, Cullera and Sueca.

Bocairent is one of the most picturesque municipalities in the province of Valencia. Its importance throughout history is evident in monumental and patrimonial vestiges excavated in the rock. Many are the caves that can be seen, such as La Cava de Sant Blai or Covetes dels Moros as well as the Medieval Quarter, La Asunción de Nuestra Señora Parish Church and the local Bullring. Moreover, its beauty and heritage can be seen in its natural wealth linked to the Natural Park of the Sierra de Mariola, its typical gastronomy and its festivities (Moors and Christians and the festivities to honor San Agustí).

Canet d'En Berenguer offers visitors a contrast between orange trees and coast, with a natural beach which is 80 meters wide, dunes, fine sand and crystal clear water.

Likewise, its marina presents extraordinary conditions for the practice of fishing and nautical tourism. It is also possible to visit the ethnological museum to know how the natives dressed, lived and behaved in the past. It is also interesting to visit the lighthouse built in 1904, the church of St. Pedro Apóstol, which dates back to the 18th century, of Gothic style and located on a previous one built in the 14th century, the manor Casa Palacio, built between the 17th - 18th centuries, and numerous farmsteads of the 13th century.

El Puig de Santa Maria is a quiet village, but with an impressive historical and monumental heritage, touched by the waters of the Mediterranean Sea and with a mild climate. There we find an interesting cultural offer, with monuments such as the monastery Real Monasterio de Santa Maria del Puig, the Carthusian monastery known as Cartuja de Ara Christi, the refuges and trenches or the printing museum, among others which witness its intense historical legacy. The village relies on a healthy Mediterranean gastronomy, based on traditional recipes from l'Horta region, reinterpreted from the perspective of avant-garde cuisine. El Puig is located at 14 km from Valencia, perfectly communicated by the Mediterranean highway, by the A-7 and by train and bus lines.

Set on a green surface of 12,250 m² this multipurpose pavilion is capable of hosting acts of all sorts; cultural, recreational, social, exhibition, etc. This construction, completely respectful with the outer space, is surrounded by green areas with slopes and bleachers, which are suitable for outdoor shows.

The rectangular pavilion has a main room of approximately 750m², which can be divided into three

smaller rooms. People can access through two entrances, to the east and to the west, so it is possible to host different events simultaneously. Dressing rooms, public bathrooms, as well as internal control spaces are some of the rooms it has. The flexibility of the spaces makes it possible to adapt to different events. The Ducal Palace of the Borgia, or Borja in Valencian, declared Asset of Cultural Interest in 1964, is one of the most representative civil buildings of the Valencian historic heritage. It is the palace that the cardinal Rodrigo de Borja bought for one of his children, thereby starting in this house a saga of eleven Dukes Borja de Gandia. It is located in the historic center, next to the collegiate church Colegiata Santa María and the Town Hall. It has rooms and spaces that are perfect for hosting events, meetings, conferences, congresses, courses, etc., due to its characteristics which grant the event with the added value of being done in a single space that is part of our historical and cultural heritage.

On the ground floor of this museum devoted to the well-known Fallas, we can see the events hall or theater, ideal for holding conferences, conventions, galas and different types of shows and events. It has enough capacity for 484 people seated on the ground floor, plus 90 people sitting on the first floor. This building also houses 2 rooms. The first room, called Multipurpose Room, is equipped with arm chairs, both artificial and natural light, Internet connection via WIFI, air conditioning and different electrical connections.

The second, called Meeting Room, is a much more complete room, designed for conferences, press conferences, courses, seminars, meetings, etc. It has natural and artificial light with equipment, electronic lighting and energy saving lights, microphones, public address and sound system, screen, projectors, WIFI, chairs with arms and air conditioning.

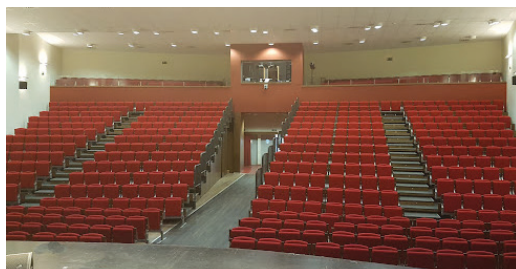

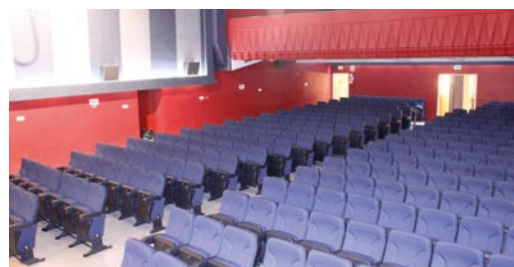

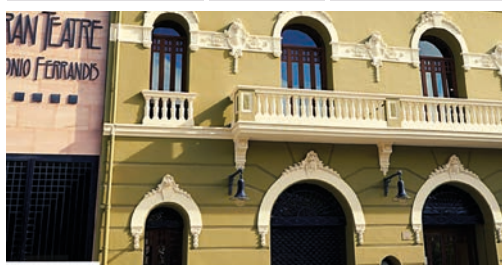

In Quart de Poblet we can find buildings as emblematic as the church known as Iglesia de la Purísima Concepción, of the 17th century, the Hermitage of San Onofre, the Town Hall, the Cultural Center "El Casino", and Casa de la Cultura, which is a typical Valencian house from the 19th century. The town maintains an intense relationship with water, so there are various constructions that turn water into a unique element: the medieval cistern, low pressure water tank of San Onofre of the 19th century, Las Lenguas de San Onofre, the diversion dam known as El Azud del Repartiment, the canal Acequia de Mislata and the Turia River Natural Park as it passes through the town, with the Center for Interpretation of Nature. Likewise, visitors can walk through several routes such as the route of water, the emblematic buildings route and the QDP 36/39 of the Spanish Civil War.

Declared a Site of Cultural Interest, it is one of the most visited monuments. Inside is the Municipal Museum of History and Archaeology, as well as different audiovisual projections on the history of Cullera and the Castle itself.



CULLERA CASTLE

High on the top of the mountain is the imposing fortress of the Castle of Cullera. Built by the Cordovan state in the 10th century for the strategic control of natural resources, communication routes and borders, it is made up of the citadel and two albacaras that fulfilled the function of sheltering the troops, cavalry, cattle and the population itself at times of siege. Cullera Castle is the result of numerous renovations, reconstructions and reforms carried out over more than a thousand years of history. From the Middle Ages to the Carlist Wars, the Castle of Cullera has been the testimony of numerous and relevant historical events.

The castle has three spaces for events: the Arms room for private meetings of up to 20 people, the Museum with a capacity of 50 people and the Patio de los aljibes, the largest with a capacity of 100 people.

BENISSANO CASTLE

Benissanó Castle dates from the second half of the 15th century and is located just over 20 km from Valencia. It can be considered as a Castle-Palace where the fortress and the stately residence are combined. Currently we can say that it is one of the best preserved in the Community. Among its rooms we must highlight: the Vestibule, the Noble Room, the Patio de Armas, the room of Francisco I King of France, lodged in 1525 as a prisoner in the Battle of *Pavia, the "Achicharrados" room,

of iron and solid brick that runs along the entire perimeter of the warehouse.

It was built by a carpenter and worker from the town named José Ríos Chinesta, who used German-Dutch architectural layouts, drawing inspiration not only from the decorative repertoires but also from the structural system. Marking the separation between the naves, there are a series of wrought iron columns with a simple classical-cut capital, on whose shaft the perimeter mezzanine is supported.



The polychromy of its facades and interior elements stands out due to the contrast of the different and varied materials, in addition to the decorative elements of eclectic tradition, with tiles and wrought iron ornaments in a modernist style.

MAGATZEM DE RIBERA (FORMER ORANGE WAREHOUSE)

The Ribera Magatzem (warehouse) is a unique building with an outstanding interest for being a symbol of industrial architecture linked to the production of oranges in the Valencian Community. It is an almost free-standing construction, with an L-shaped floor plan, and which combines the two schemes typical of old hospitals and prisons, since its two naves can be seen from their intersection, with a basilica-shaped floor plan.

It consists of a central nave of greater dimension and height with lower aisles, allowing natural lighting from the top of the dividing walls between them. Its structure is completed by a gallery-like mezzanine made

BOCAIRENT BULLRING (HEWN IN THE ROCK)

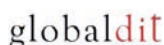
